

# Martin County ARES/RACES Information Net Sample Script

**Attention all Amateur radio operators. This is <Your Call>. My name is <Your Name> and I will be your Net Control Station for this evening's session of the Martin County ARES/RACES Information Net.**

**Any stations with emergency or priority traffic please call now.**

*(Handle all emergency or priority traffic before proceeding)*

**We welcome all licensed amateurs within the sound of this repeater to join our net - you do not have to be a member of Martin County ARES/RACES to participate.**

**The purpose of this net is for training in emergency communications, exchanging information related to Martin County ARES/RACES, and to handle National Traffic System messages.**

**Please do not interrupt the net to check in unless you have EMERGENCY traffic. Please wait patiently until the NCS requests additional check ins.**

**When initially checking in, please slowly state your call sign using standard phonetics and your first name. It is not necessary, nor desired, to say "this is", un-key, and then send your call sign. I will acknowledge all calls heard and ask for any missed calls.**

*(At this point begin requesting check in's)*

**Any stations with traffic, bulletins, or announcements or any mobile or short-of-time stations please call now.**

*(Acknowledge any callsigns you heard and ask if any stations were missed)*

*(Next request check in's by zone. Acknowledge any callsigns you heard and ask if any stations were missed after each zone.)*

**Any stations in zone 1 - south of cove road but east of us1 please call now.**

**Any stations in zone 2 east of us 1 and north of cove rd please call now**

**Any stations in zone 3 west of us1 but east of I95 and north of cove rd please call now**

**Any stations in zone 4 west of us1 but east of I95 and south of cove rd please call now**

**Any stations in zone 5 west of I-95 please call now**

**Any stations outside of martin county please call now**

*(Go through the list starting with those stations that had traffic, bulletins, or announcements.)*

*(Once the announcements have been completed, proceed with mobiles/ short-of-timers and then down the remainder of the list in the order that the stations checked in.)*

*(Be sure to request additional check in's periodically )*

*(Remember to ID with your callsign at least every 10 minutes)*

*(Closing)*

**I would like to thank all stations for participating in tonight's net. This net meets every Thursday at 8pm local time on 145.150 mhz. This is <Your Call> closing this session of the Martin County ARES/RACES Information Net and returning this repeater back to general amateur radio use.**
